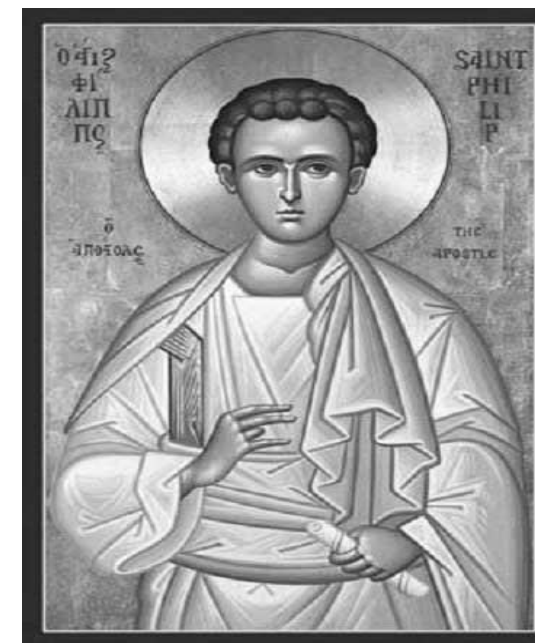

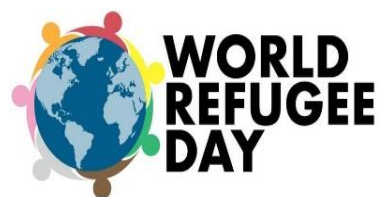

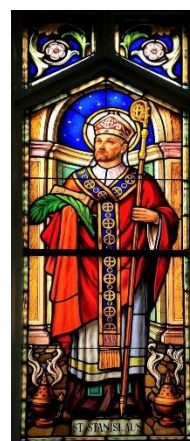
The veggies will arrive at Assumption de Notre Dame on Friday September 29th and you will need to pick up your veggies over there 15 minutes before or after mass on Oct 1st. We will not be able to store your veggies past October 1st. Any veggie bags not picked up will be donated.

You can also buy a bag of veggies to donate to those in need. On the order form there will be a place to indicate that the vegetables are to be donated and won't be picked up.
