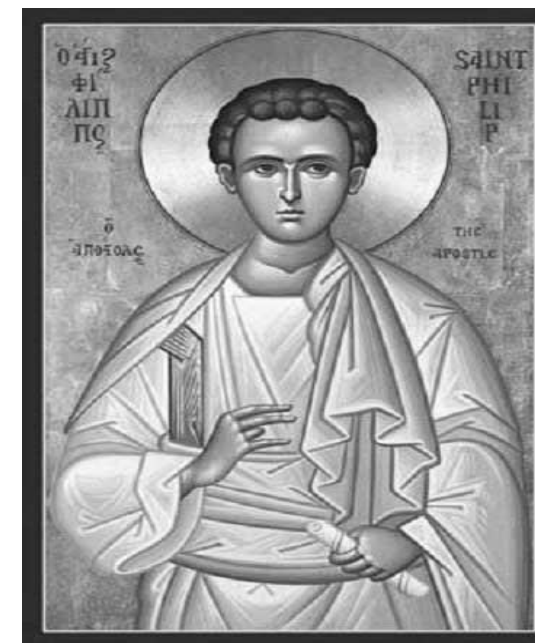

The veggies will arrive at Assomption de Notre Dame on Friday September 29<sup>th</sup> and you will need to pick up your veggies over there 15 minutes before or after mass on Oct 1<sup>st</sup>. We will not be able to store your veggies past October 1<sup>st</sup>. Any veggie bags not picked up will be donated.

You can also buy a bag of veggies to donate to those in need. On the order form there will be a place to indicate that the vegetables are to be donated and won't be picked up.
