

Thanksgiving Vegetable Fundraiser

St. Philip the Apostle is proud to partner once again with Willowtree Farm for a unique fundraiser. We will be selling Fresh from the Farm, local vegetables for your Thanksgiving dinner. Each bag will contain; 1 seasonal squash, 1 cauliflower or cabbage, 2 onions, garlic, carrots, beets, and potatoes for \$25. We will load up the bags with fresh veggies and will make substitutions based on what is ready to harvest.

Pick up your order envelope. Fill out the order form. Place your order form with your payment in the envelope. Drop off your Thanksgiving Vegetable Fundraiser envelope in the special basket in the back of the Church. All orders must be in by Sunday September 24th.

The veggies will arrive at Assomption de Notre Dame on Friday September 29th and you will need to pick up your veggies over there 15 minutes before or after mass on Oct 1st. We will not be able to store your veggies past October 1st. Any veggie bags not picked up will be donated.

You can also buy a bag of veggies to donate to those in need. On the order form there will be a place to indicate that the vegetables are to be donated and won't be picked up.


