# World Day of the Poor 2023

"Do Not Turn Away" "Give alms from your possessions. Do not turn your face away from any of the poor, and God's face will not be

turned away from you."

It is the phrase in bold which Pope Francis has chosen for the theme of his message for World Day of the Poor which takes place THIS Sunday. However, the rest of the sentence encourages us to treat the poor as we would want God to treat us. And the call to give alms goes beyond merely providing material support; it is an invitation to be engaged with those in need, walk alongside, and provide help and support.


