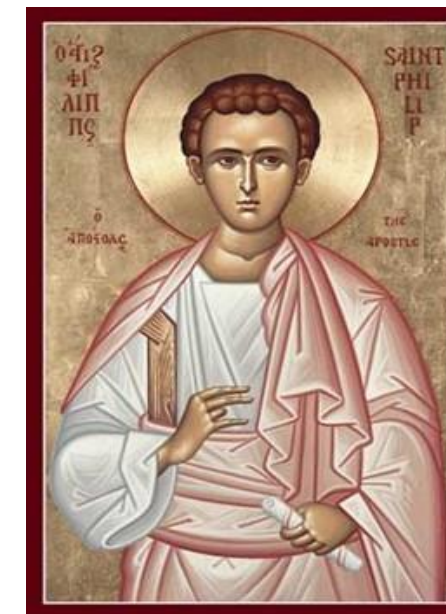

The Most Holy Trinity Sunday
