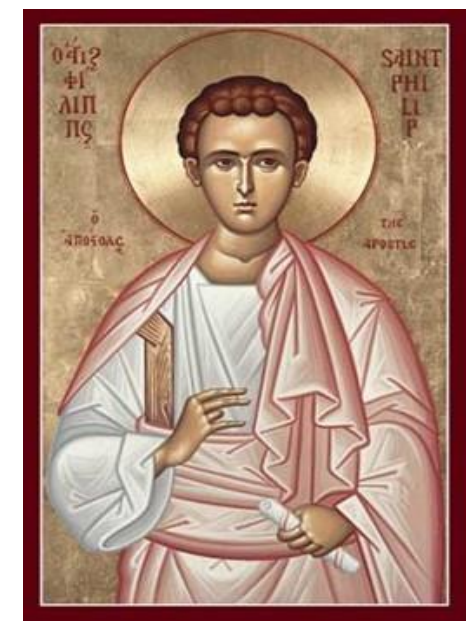



**Saint Ephrem (June 9):**  
 Ephrem lived from about 306 to 373. Born Mesopotamia, Ephrem was baptized at 18 and eventually became a deacon, but he humbly refused ordination to the priesthood. After the fall of his home city to the Persians in 363, Ephrem retired to a life of solitude in a care to write commentaries and hymns. Recognizing the power of music and poetry to evangelize, he was the first to introduce hymns into public worship. Cited the “Harp of the Holy Spirit,” he died at Edessa on June 9<sup>th</sup>. In 1920, he became a Doctor of the Church.



**Saint Barnabas (June 11):**  
 Barnabas, a Jew from Cyprus, came to Jerusalem, where he joined the Christian community. The apostles changed his name from Jospheh to Barnabas, or “man of encouragement.” Our knowledge of Barnabas is recorded by Luke in Acts: he was a good man, full of the Holy Spirit and of faith. It was Barnabas who accepted Paul into the community after his conversion and who was at Paul’s side for many years as his partner evangelizing the Gentiles. Tradition says he was stoned to death in Cyprus about the year 61.
