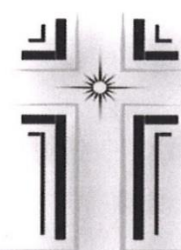

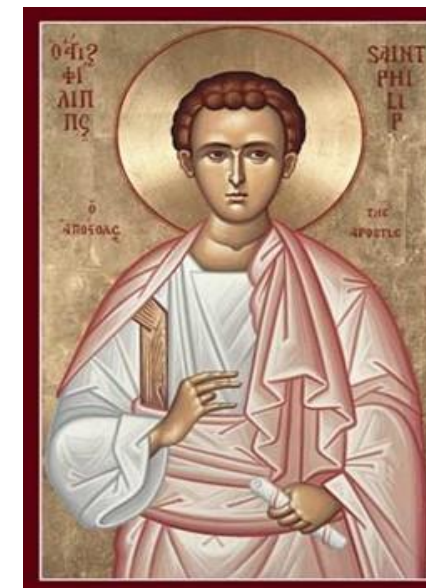

Saint Hedwig - October 20

Hedwig was born in Bavaria about the year 1174. At the age of 12 she married 18-year-old Henry Duke of Silesia. In 1202 Henry succeeded his father, and the Duke and Duchess began their first project, building the

great Cistercian monastery for women at Trebnitz near Breslau. This was followed by many more foundations of different orders, and included two hospitals. From 1209 Hedwig's principal residence was near Trebnitz, where she lived a life of extreme austerity, helping the poor and prisoners and often spending time in the monastery, following its rule. Henry died in 1243, having outlived all her seven children but one who became abbess at Trebnitz.



Saint Margaret Mary Alacoque (October 20)

Margaret was born in 1647 in Burgundy, France. At 14, having been cured of a lengthy illness, she decided to become a nun. It

was not until 1671, however, that she was able to enter the Visitation convent at Paray-le-Monial. Between 1673 and 1676 she experienced four visions concerning the Sacred Heart, and was told to record them by her confessor, the brilliant Jesuit Claude la Colombiere. By 1686, the community too was honouring the heart of Jesus, and in 1688 a chapel in the garden was consecrated to the Sacred Heart. Two years later Margaret died, but the devotion she began at Paray was now firmly established.
