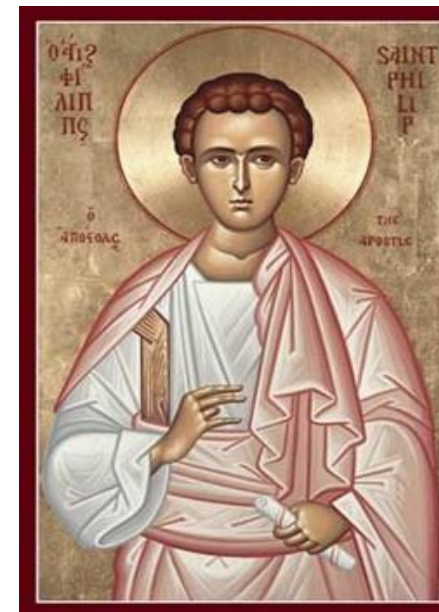

Our Lady of the Rosary (Oct. 7)

In ancient times, Marian feasts of the Eastern Church centered on events in Mary's life. Since the 12th century, Marian feasts added to the Western calendar almost always commemorate a particular event of the times. Our Lady of the Rosary was celebrated in the late 15th century by some confraternities of the rosary, and in 1571 was solemnized by Pius V in thanksgiving for a battle victory. In 1716, Clement XI extended the feast to the universal Church.
